Assessments

I am continually sending all schools updated information on ILEARN, I AM, IREAD3, ISTEP+10, WIDA, and ISPROUT. I continue to view required trainings as the corporation test coordinator. We are still doing ILEARN 3-8 testing which will conclude on May 13. ILEARN Biology testing has been concluded. SAT alternate testing for Juniors who missed the primary testing date concluded on April 20. NWEA testing opened on May 2 and will conclude on May 20.

State Reports

The April state report window which included the second special education report was successfully pulled and signed on April 11. July reports are now available for corrections of errors and exclusions. I am working with PowerSchool to correct entries that are causing errors and exclusions. I have been watching IDOE webinars and will be watching PowerSchool webinars to learn more about those corrections.

Special Education/English Learners

Shayla Hall sends me information regularly to keep me informed of any issues. I continue to receive information and updates from KASEC and attend coordinator meetings. I assist with case conferences as needed.

Transportation

Laurie Crawford is doing an excellent job of keeping the drivers informed of new students and any changes with students on the various bus routes. She is working to keep the routes in Traversa up to date. Mrs. Crawford is continuing to schedule ECA transportation and is working to stay at least a month ahead on the scheduling. At present, we are able to keep up with ECA activities and cover for absent drivers, but we are stretched very thin. Laurie and I have spent a lot of time attempting to shuffle drivers in order to keep things covered. I have completed driver evaluations and have met with them for their April 22 eLearning day activity. I have completed their finalization evaluations and will be making those available for them to sign. Laurie and I met with drivers to start the discussion and process of modifying routes.

Other Items

I continue to help with and answer questions concerning PowerSchool and other day-to-day school operations. I am working to address issues with PowerSchool concerning its communication with DataExchange and the various state reports that will be pulled directly from

PowerSchool. I am continuing to check PowerSchool for errors that need to be corrected so that it functions properly with DataExchange.

The special education state report loaded DataExchange with no problems.
