

## **PARTICIPATION OF NON-PUBLIC AND HOMESCHOOLED STUDENTS**

The Tipton Community School Corporation (“Corporation”) Board of School Trustees (“Board”) recognizes that some school-age children residing in the Corporation are enrolled in non-public schools or are being homeschooled. Notification that a child is receiving an equivalent education program at home should be submitted to the Superintendent.

A student who is being educated at a non-public school or at home may be allowed to participate in one or more of the Corporation's on-going, co-curricular or extracurricular activities if the student meets the eligibility criteria for enrolled students established for the activity. The participation will be limited to those activities which are ongoing rather than a single event. Students seeking participation in high school athletics are also bound by Indiana High School Athletic Association (IHSAA) regulations.

A student who is being educated at a non-public school or at home may be allowed to enroll in one or more program courses provided that the enrollment request is submitted in writing to the Superintendent or his or her designee prior to September 1 of that school year. The Superintendent or his or her designee will consider the request based on space availability and course requirements. Transportation will be the responsibility of the parents. Such student enrollments will be submitted to the State for funding purposes.

Participation in Corporation activities or programs is a privilege. Students enrolled in Corporation activities or programs are bound by Corporation policies and the student code of conduct. A student may be dismissed from the program or activity immediately for violation of the Corporation policy or student code of conduct.
